

#### **Isaiah 43:25**

"I—yes, I alone—will blot out your sins for my own sake and will never think of them again."

#### Mark 2:1-12

¹When Jesus returned to Capernaum several days later, the news spread quickly that he was back home. ² Soon the house where he was staying was so packed with visitors that there was no more room, even outside the door. While he was preaching God's word to them, ³ four men arrived carrying a paralyzed man on a mat. ⁴ They couldn't bring him to Jesus because of the crowd, so they dug a hole through the roof above his head. Then they lowered the man on his mat, right down in front of Jesus.

- <sup>5</sup> Seeing their faith, Jesus said to the paralyzed man, "My child, your sins are forgiven." <sup>6</sup> But some of the teachers of religious law who were sitting there thought to themselves, <sup>7</sup> "What is he saying? This is blasphemy! Only God can forgive sins!"
- <sup>8</sup> Jesus knew immediately what they were thinking, so he asked them, "Why do you question this in your hearts? <sup>9</sup> Is it easier to say to the paralyzed man 'Your sins are forgiven,' or 'Stand up, pick up your mat, and walk'? <sup>10</sup> So I will prove to you that the Son of Man has the authority on earth to forgive sins." Then Jesus turned to the paralyzed man and said, <sup>11</sup> "Stand up, pick up your mat, and go home!"
- <sup>12</sup> And the man jumped up, grabbed his mat, and walked out through the stunned onlookers. They were all amazed and praised God, exclaiming, "We've never seen anything like this before!"



### **Memory Verse:**

Seeing their faith, Jesus said to the paralyzed man, "My child, your sins are forgiven." (Mark 2:5)

#### **Three Points:**

- 1. Jesus knows what is really going on with you.
- 2. When you know that you're forgiven, you can start moving again.
- 3. Your faith can help your friends.
