Ministry Trip Awareness

MINISTRY TEAMS

Everyone on the trip functions as a team. Each trip will not exceed 12 people to ensure a healthy but full group. There may be times where we split into smaller groups, but only if the leadership asks and we agree as a team. We will have meetings leading up to the trip to get to know each other as best as we can. We will be in shared rooms during our stay and will be in close contact during travel time in Guatemala.

MINISTRY CONDITIONS

Some of the places and conditions we may encounter as a team can seem primitive in comparison to what we are used to. The pace required on these trips can be rigorous, emotionally draining and tiresome. We ask that you are prepared to “run and not grow weary, to walk and not faint”. We also encourage everyone to look out for everyone on the team and be mindful that everyone is coming with different needs and experiences. We are in this together and it will bond us like nothing else!

MINISTRY MEETINGS/ AGENDA

The key word is FLEXIBILITY! We will receive our “final” agenda approximately 30 days prior to departure, but hold it loosely and with an open mind. Scheduling and events often change and get refigured. We ask you to be fluid and trusting of the Holy Spirit to move within the agenda.



Terms and Conditions

DEPOSIT AND ACCEPTANCE INFORMATION:

A mandatory deposit reserves your spot on the trip. Your deposit will be required after your application has been accepted. (Deposit amount is \$150.00)

COST OF TRIP INFORMATION

The cost of the trip includes round trip airfare, indigenous team leader, international medical insurance, lodging, 3 meals, bottled water (but are encouraged to bring your own reusable water bottle so they can purchase the 5 gallon jugs at a cheaper cost), ground transportation when in-country. This accounts for the "rest day" as well.

You will be responsible for your travel cost to and from the hub airport, personal spending money, the cost of personal snacks, gratuity when appropriate (hotel rooms), and, additional passport fees.

IMPORTANT PAYMENT INFORMATION

All payment will need be entered into your personal Managed Missions account

You will receive links for both the Managed Mission account as well as King's Mission donation account for people to donate to you

Both will be tax deductible

There will be a few deadlines for certain amounts of funds to be entered.

CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY

The 410 Bridge is a registered 501(C) 3 not-for-profit organization so they are unable to give refunds. Any cancellation will incur the loss of your deposit and/or additional cancellation fees.

We will attempt to apply donations towards other members of the trip, or to hold for your future trips.

They drove out many demons, anointed many sick people with oil and healed them". -Mark 6:7-13
