Bill Curry, Former Presidential Counselor and CT Governor Candidate, Will Discuss Climate and Democracy with Third Act CT on Oct. 7

September 23, 2024 – Bill Curry, former Counselor to the President in the Clinton Administration and two-time Democratic candidate for Governor of Connecticut, will be the featured speaker at an all-in meeting of Third Act Connecticut on **Monday, Oct. 7, from 1 to 3 pm**, at the Rocky Hill Congregational Church, 805 Old Main Street, Rocky Hill.

<u>Third Act Connecticut</u> is the state's chapter of the national <u>Third Act</u> organization, the advocacy community of Americans aged 60-plus. The event is free; all members of Third Act Connecticut and the public are invited to attend.

Mr. Curry's talk is entitled "Pick Your Grandchildren's Future" and will cover issues related to climate change and democracy. A question-and-answer session will follow his talk.

In 1978, at the age of 26, Mr. Curry was elected state senator and served two terms; he also has been Connecticut state comptroller. He served in the Clinton White House from 1995 to 1997 and was Democratic candidate for governor in 1994 and 2002. He also has practiced law and worked in public policy positions in Washington, D.C.; currently, he is a political columnist for <u>Salon</u>.

"Bill has been a prominent truth-telling political figure in CT for decades, and no one knows the political possibilities and perils of Connecticut and the nation the way he does," said Davida Foy Crabtree, a Third Act Connecticut leader. "A dynamic and motivating speaker, he will both challenge attendees and provide inspiration for the challenging work yet to be done."
