		<p>-Explained process of curriculum changes that might be needed as result of the new TEKS:          -SHAC will be responsible to review and providing a recommendation: family violence, human trafficking, sexual health, dating violence and present to board</p> <p>-Timeline going through adoptions at the same time TEKS will be going into effect</p> <p>-Textbook committees are currently looking at resources and publishers and will make recommendation to board</p> <p>-curriculum needs to be aligned to TEKS</p> <p>-Questions/Comments:</p> <p><b>Are there any budgetary barriers to adoptions? NO</b></p> <p>RB: We had at least 30 members participating in reviews; rubric includes diverse and rigorous criteria to evaluate resources. Committees then selected 2-3 publishers in December. Committees then made a recommendation after a second evaluation of the health and physical education resources.</p> <p><b>Committees have thus far recommended:</b></p> <p>HealthSmart selected by MS/HS; been in district since 2014. 		<p>-we've met with several parents, one parent has opted, all the others opted in.</p> <p>-1 HS parent did not opt in, but does want to purchase curriculum to teach curriculum to child</p> <p>-Strategies for reaching to parents: paper form sending out by health teachers, google form digital form so teachers can post in google classroom, voicemail through blackboard or google classroom. Last resort is looking at FOCUS and text message parents to ensure they have received forms when there is no response. Lot of work on teachers but responsibility to ensure parents have choice for their child.</p> <p>-we welcome parents to TLC and also if not convenient we arrange time at their school. Some parents state they didn't learn this in school so parents want to know how to be involved with education. We're thinking about helping to facilitate conversations through a conversation guide.</p> <p>-<b>QUESTION:</b> How can we see the curriculum? OF COURSE, ABSOLUTELY so we can get together and take a look at the curriculum. Letters go home at the beginning of each unit. In some places we're still using workbooks, others are digital; especially HS. Time TO TALKS go home to facilitate conversation.</p> <p>-<b>QUESTIONS:</b> Was it typical numbers we saw. This is the first semester that we're tracking data, it's important; especially no return rates is concerning. We're going to make sure parents get information.
