I feel we are very unique for a summer camp. We are in Northeastern Pennsylvania! About a 3.5 hour drive from the city Kds from 8 to 16 years old.



Founded in 1964 by 2 New Yorkers, tired of how the education system was planned and more curious about alternative education models. Purposely small program so everybody knows everyone (1:3 ratio, 170 campers, 70 staff members)

# We have 3 music programs:

- 1- music and vocal program: classes and many performances opportunities (campers cabaret, informal "5 o'clock special from a piece of work)
- 2- rock music program: huge and very popular, cast into bands, one giant rock show at the end, vary different songs, original music too
- 3- musical theater program: very popular and diverse. Non competitive camp so everyone who wants to be in a show can be in a show. Everything is done by the kids, even the set. We perform one original new show every summer, happy to support composers and their new work.



Because we are so small, we quickly open a waitlist.


