

Defining an HTML Table

An HTML table is defined with the **<table>** tag.

Each table row is defined with the **<tr>** tag. A table header is defined with the **<th>** tag. By default, table headings are bold and centered. A table data/cell is defined with the **<td>** tag.

Example

<html>
<body>

<table style="width:100%">
  <tr>
    <th>Firstname</th>
    <th>Lastname</th>
    <th>Age</th>
  </tr>
  <tr>
    <td>Jill</td>
    <td>Smith</td>
    <td>50</td>
  </tr>
  <tr>
    <td>Eve</td>
    <td>Jackson</td>
    <td>94</td>
  </tr>
  <tr>
    <td>John</td>
    <td>Doe</td>
    <td>80</td>
  </tr>
</table>

</body>
</html>
```

The table will look like this.

	Firstname	Lastname	Age
Jill		Smith	50
Eve		Jackson	94
John		Doe	80

To make the border you add this **above the <body> tag**

```
<head>
<style>
table, th, td {
    border: 1px solid black;
    border-collapse: collapse;
}
</style>
</head>
```

Change the table

- Give the table a boarder.
- Make the Ages show first.
- Change the names and ages to your name and the names and ages of two people you know
- For an extra 2 of 10 points, change the headings Age, Lastname and Firstname to Dodger Blue.
