BUS PARKING: Buses should be parked along the south side of Gray Street.

ENTRIES: Entries for the conference meet must be entered through Athletics.net. The host school shall arrange for computer seeding and meet scoring. After the seeding meeting, substitutions may be made only for illness or injury and will require a statement signed by the Principal or Athletic Director. There will be a virtual seeding meeting at 6:00pm on Tuesday, May 5 prior to the conference meet. Entries are due by 10:00 pm on Monday, May 4.

RESULTS: Athletic.net and AthleticLive

SCORING: The meet will be scored 10 - 8 - 6 - 5 - 4 - 3 - 2 - 1 by level. Awards will be given to the top 6 in each scoring event (medals for Varsity, ribbons for Frosh/Soph).

MEET WORKERS: Each school shall provide 2 qualified adult workers to work the conference meet. The host school may pre-assign worker assignments with input from the schools. Every school is requested to provide a competent adult worker for a field event. The Games Committee shall consist of the Meet Manager and all Head Coaches. Coach Raak will work with the other head coaches on assignments.

ADMISSION: \$7 for all adults and \$3 for all student spectators. Cash and GoFan will be available. Please email your completed Pass Gate List to jmain@geneva304.org by 3:00 pm on Wednesday, May 6, 2026. Only those listed on the Pass List will be allowed free admission to the competition.

HOSPITALITY: The GHS All Sports Boosters will provide a light dinner for the judges and coaching staff.

CONCESSIONS: Concessions will be provided by the GHS All Sports Boosters.

TRAINERS: An Athletic Trainer will be available on-site to treat any injuries. Teams must provide their own supplies for preventative treatment. Please tape your athletes using your own supplies for existing injuries.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- Please clean your team camp area at the conclusion of the meet. You may use the away bleachers as a team camp. Tents may be used on grass areas only, and as always, please secure your tents to help keep a safe meet environment.
- No tape may be used on the track. Please use chalk.
- Restrooms are located behind the home side bleachers.
- ¼-inch spikes are permitted.
