The 3 most important skills students must master by the end of the year:	Student data documenting the need to address the identified skills:
Skill 1: By the end the year, your child should be able to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Recognize and name letters and their sounds as well as use these skills to build words. 	In June of 2021, 49% of the students in K-2 were far below in foundational skills such as letter recognition, letter sounds, and blending words to build reading fluency.
Skill 2: By the end of year, your child should be able to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ask and answer questions about key details in text. 	In June of 2021, 49% of the students in PK-2 were far below in foundational skills such as letter recognition, letter sounds, and blending words to build reading fluency.
Skill 3: By the end of year, your child should be able to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Know their grade-level high frequency words. 	In Acadience Spring 2021 data, over 60% of students did not automatically recognize their grade-level high frequency words.

What families could do to help at Home

To help students master Skill 1:

- Ensure that your child reads every night! Make reading fun!
- DYAD read w/ your child a few times a week.
- Practice letter names and sounds. Have them make words every day.

To help students master Skill 2:

- Ask "w" questions: who, what, when, where, why
- Ask what happened at the beginning, middle, and end of the story.
- Ask your child what the main idea of the story is and what key details support the main idea.

To help students master Skill 3:

- Practice grade level high frequency words from their grade-level list- have them say it, spell it, and write it.
