Students will work independently, in pairs, and in groups throughout the year. All students are strongly encouraged to ask a parent, classmate, another 5th grader, or a teacher for help until they understand a concept completely.

Classwork/ Homework: Completing homework when assigned is critical to success in 5th grade. Students are expected to copy down homework in their planner. Homework assignments may also be found on our <u>Fifth Grade Webpage</u>. Homework is due at the start of class. Late work will be accepted with a late pass (students are provided one pass per trimester) and receive full credit. Late work without a late pass may still be reviewed together by the teacher and student; however, it will not count for credit. Homework for science will occasionally be studying for an upcoming test, or perhaps finishing unfinished classwork.

Assessments: Students will create their study guide throughout each segment. During assessments, students will use their study guides in their binders and notebooks. Students will not be allowed to retake assessments. Ouizzes will be given throughout the

sequence of learning. If students are scoring lower than 72.4% then they may be in danger of scoring lower than a C in the class, and a student, parent, or teacher conference will be scheduled.

Grading: Please give up to two weeks for assessments and projects to be graded. If you turn work in late, give me two weeks from your turn-in date to complete your grading.
