Welcome to the Duncan Livestock Prospect Steer Sale. Once again, we are offering our best prospect steers and heifers. No steers or heifers have been sold prior to the sale.

We would like to thank our buyers from our 2015 sale.

Bidding Process

All bids are to be in minimum \$50 increments. The bidding process for all cattle runs as a silent auction until a 3 minute warning is given on the animal that sells first and so on. All steers will sell first, followed by commercial heifers, and then purebred heifers. The first lot to sell in each group will be the sale entry that has the most bids at 2:00 pm on Saturday, September 3. If there is a tie in the number of bids, the animal which is the oldest will sell first. During the final 3 minutes, all bidders can continue to bid on any animal still for sale. After 3 minutes is up, those buyers only with bids in the silent auction on the designated lot will be asked to come forward if they wish to continue bidding in a live bid off for those bidders only. For example on paper, buyer # 100 bid \$2000 on lot 50, then buyer # 200 bid \$2050, buyer # 300 bid \$2100, and before the end of the 3 minute warning, buyer # 400 bids \$2150. We would then ask buyer #s 100, 200, 300, and 400 to come forward for the live bid off. The first option would go to the first bid taken from buyer # 100 for \$2200, if buyer # 100 accepts, then we move next to buyer # 200 for \$2250 and so on in \$50 increments until one buyer is left who has agreed to the top price. If you have any questions, let us know. Bidders have the option when it is their turn to increase the bidding increment by more than \$50 if they chose.

All calves were weaned in late July. All calves were vaccinated with modified live Pyramid FP 5 + Presponse and Vision 8 Somnus with SPUR. All calves were treated with Bimectin at different times during the year. CCIA age verification birth certificates are available on all calves upon request.

October 2016-2017 Calves

Our next set of calves will start arriving in September. Service sires are Believe in Me, Boardwalk, , Eye Candy, I-80, Monopoly, Unstoppable, Walk This Way, and Walks Alone. Once again, our club calf cows and heifers sired by Boardwalk, Eye Candy, Monopoly, and Who Made Who are bred to the Genex calving ease sires, PVF Insight 0129 and SAV Angus Valley 1867. All of these calves will be offered for sale in 2017. Many of our purebred Angus cows have been bred to purebred Angus bulls for this calving season using the following sires; Dameron C5 American Classic, Dameron First Impression, PVF Insight 0129, SAV Angus Valley 1867, SAV Resource 1441, and Silveiras Style 9303. Bannockburn Valley Farm's JS Upward 20Z has been on site since early June. Our purebred fall 2016 and winter 2017 calves will also be offered for sale in 2017.
