## Transfer Policy

***A student may transfer from an AP or Honors class at the end of 4 weeks in the first grading period of school or at the semester.***

***Transfers beyond the first grading period window may be granted with administrative approval. To transfer out of an AP or Honors course, the AP or Honors course withdrawal form must be filled out. A conference with the parent/guardian, teacher, and the student will be required to determine the future placement of the student.***
