General Membership Meeting

August 19<sup>th</sup>, 2025

PTA President Angela Twibey called the meeting to order at 4:01 p.m. A quorum was established with 11 PTA members in attendance including Courtney May, Angela Twibey, Patricia Moore, Aubree Blau, Jaclyn Rogers, April Gill, Abbie Ford, Katie Jones, Vera Whitlock, Cathy Smyth, and Jared Broderick. We had a special guest, Councilman Burgess, in attendance.

PTA Treasurer Cathy Smith reviewed the budget. There was a motion to approve the budget made by Angela Twibey, seconded by Courtney may. The budget was approved by the majority with one point of discussion as brought up by Aubree Blau. Clarification provided.

General Membership meeting dates were set. The carnival was discussed and plans for the snow cone booth were established.

Membership Chair Angela Twibey reviewed a plan for a membership drive with the theme “PTA Membership is Sweet”. The proposal was accepted with some minor recommendations and changes including the dates the drive would occur, ensuring that the flyers went out in English and Spanish, and the best way to collect the memberships was discussed. The goal is to increase membership numbers by 100 memberships. Book Fair Chair, Courtney May, called for volunteers to help run the Scholastic Book Fair on September 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup>. Advertisement of e-Wallet was discussed. The best time to close the book fair (7:30 PM) was also decided upon. The fundraising chair gave information and updates regarding the dates of the World’s Finest Chocolate Fundraiser beginning with a kickoff assembly on Monday, September 22<sup>nd</sup> and ending Wednesday, October 8<sup>th</sup>. It was decided that October 10<sup>th</sup> would be a good day to submit the final order. A Spirit Night Chair was assigned- Jaclyn Rogers. She agreed to gather information and set up this year’s spirit nights. Future dates and places of the spirit nights were discussed as another source of raising funds. Tentatively, they are set for Thursday, October 30<sup>th</sup>; Friday, February 13<sup>th</sup>; and Friday, April 17<sup>th</sup>.

New business up for discussion included SEP dinner ideas for the faculty and staff and when would be a best time to cater versus make it ourselves. It was decided that a taco bar would be best for the second night of SEP’s in September (18<sup>th</sup>) and that we would revisit the budget later in the year in regards to Olive Garden for SEPs in the Spring.



Principal Broderick thanked everyone for coming and addressed Councilman Burgess.

President Twibey thanked all for coming and reminded everyone to keep track of their volunteer hours and submit them regularly and invited everyone to attend the Custom Events Carnival on September 4<sup>th</sup>. The meeting adjourned at 5:02 p.m.
