from autocratic tyrannies to bountiful democracies. Our legacies of our nation will be remembered in all and our government will be known for eternity and copied down.

Article 1: The Executive Branch

The Executive Branch will consist of a singular president. Presidents can serve an infinite number of terms and will be elected every two weeks in a set of 3 election polls in r/Pollland. Using the “candidate” flair, citizens can run for president in the election poll. Also, people can nominate citizens to be candidates, but the nominees have to agree. The president has the power to veto proposed laws, create executive orders, and interpret the Constitution.

Article 2: The Legislative Branch

Using the “Law” flair, citizens can create laws to determine the country. Each proposed law must have a description of the proposition and an option to vote “yes” or “no”. The law passes if more than 50% of the voters voted for it, and it fails if more than 50% of the voters voted against it. If the president vetoes a law, the legislative branch has the power to repeal the veto if two-thirds of the people agree with it. Executive orders can also be repealed if one-half of the people agree with it. If a president is thought of to be too tyrannical, then the people have the right to post an impeachment inquiry. If more than 50% of the people pass it, then the impeachment poll starts. If two-thirds of the people vote for the president to be impeached, the president will be impeached, otherwise, the president stays in power.

Article 3: Rights of the People

Each person, citizen of Pollland or not, has these fundamental rights:

1. The right to vote for laws, elections, repealing, impeachment inquiries, and impeachment polls.
2. The right to free speech in the Discord and Subreddit within the boundaries of the rules set in place by Panda.
3. The right to post miscellaneous posts, which includes fanart, flag designs, country designs, memes, and discussions.
4. The right to practice whatever religion, Polllandian or not, within the Discord and Subreddit.
5. The freedom to write about Pollland inside or outside of the Discord and Subreddit.
6. The freedom to vote for Amendment polls.

Article 4: Rights and Responsibilities of the Citizens

To gain citizenship of Pollland, people must either join the r/Pollland subreddit or the Pollland discord. All citizens have the power to run for president, hold an impeachment inquiry, and to create laws, and other things mentioned in Amendment 2 and Amendment 5. Citizens must be proud and patriotic of their country, and must serve in the military if an invasion were to occur.

Article 5: The Amendment Process

The people of Pollland have the right to make necessary edits to the Constitution by Amendments. Amendments are made through amendment polls, which are created by citizens. If 75% of the people vote for the amendment, it passes, otherwise, it fails. Any part of Articles 3, 5, and 6 cannot be removed.

Article 6: Moderation Powers

u/Communist-panda123 is moderator unless he/she passes it down. Moderators do not interfere with any political activity, unless it is removing posts that break the rules.

Article 7: Constitution's Powers

The Constitution is the supreme law of the land and all laws have to follow the Constitution.

Article 8: Ratification

This Constitution is to be ratified if Panda personally approves of it and if two-thirds of the people vote for it, otherwise, it fails to pass and is to be ratified again.
