Chrome Apps and Extensions

[BookTrack](#): Students can record themselves reading and hear what needs to be edited in their paper. They can also add music to their written work.

[MoveNote for Google Drive](#): Students can add video and audio to their Google Doc to explain their work.

[Announcify](#): Reads aloud every website.

[BeeLine Reader](#): BeeLine's color gradient makes reading faster/easier for over 90% of people.

[Bookmark Manager](#): Add images and notes to your bookmarks to make them more helpful. Also, Google will suggest a folder if it seems like it could be a fit.

[Cite This For Me](#): Simply browse to the page you wish to cite and click the button to generate a correctly formatted citation.

[Diigo Web Collector](#): Diigo is the #1 extension for annotating, archiving and bookmarking web pages.

[Fluency Tutor for Google](#): Lets students record themselves reading and share with the teacher - away from the pressures of reading aloud in the classroom environment.

[Google Dictionary](#): View definitions easily as you browse the web.

[Google Keep](#): Speak a voice memo on the go and have it automatically transcribed. Grab a photo of a poster, receipt or document and easily organize or find it later in search.

[Grammarly](#): Checks your grammar and spelling anywhere you write on the web.

[Haiku Deck](#): The fastest, easiest new way to create and share beautiful presentations.

[Nimbus Screenshot and Screencast](#): Capture the web page, either part of it or the whole browser window, edit your screenshots in a very user-friendly interface. Record screencasts - record video from your screen.

[OpenDyslexic](#): Open-Dyslexic is an open sourced font created to increase readability for readers with dyslexia.

[Read & Write for Google Chrome:](#) Read&Write for Google Chrome offers a range of powerful support tools to help students gain confidence with reading, writing, studying and research.

[Save to Drive:](#) Helps you save web content or browser screenshots to your Google Drive.

[Speak It:](#) SpeakIt reads selected text using Text-to-Speech technology with language auto-detection. It can read text in more than 50 languages.

[Storybird:](#) Creative digital storytelling tool

[Turn off the lights:](#) The page will turn dark so you can focus on the video.

[Visor:](#) Screen dimmer and reading aid, may help with fluency, eye-strain, concentration and comprehension while reading.

[Readability:](#) provides a better way to read online, turning any web page into a comfortable reading view right in your web browser.

[Explain and Send Screenshots:](#) This extension is a must if you find that you are taking screenshots, annotating them, and then sending them to teachers/students.

[One Tab:](#) Combine all your opened browser tabs into a list (think of playlists) that you can save and restore later. Allows you to set up your browser ahead of time with specific tabs/sites already loaded. You can also name each list as well as share each list as a webpage for your students/attendees to access.

[PrintWhatYouLike:](#) Select portions of the page that you'd like to print by selecting those sections you want to ignore.

[Select and Speak:](#) Select text on a website and have this text-to-speech tool read it to you. You can select the voice and set the speed. You may also right-click on the selected text to access this extension.

[Speechpad:](#) This voice recognition tool allows students to dictate into any text field on the web. Once installed, users right-click within a text box, select SpeechPad, and begin speaking.
