

To apply for DePaul scholarships, you must complete the following steps. Please see specific scholarship pages for application instructions for national and features scholarships.

- 1) If you have not done so already for the current academic year, complete the [FAFSA](#) (Application for Federal Student Aid) and have the results sent to DePaul University. This is only required for need-based scholarships.
 - a) You are not required to complete the FAFSA to log into Scholarship Connect or complete a general application, but it is required when need is a component of the award.
 - b) Please note that students are not required to accept financial aid packages in order to be considered for need-based scholarships. They need only fill out and submit the application.
 - c) Any federal financial aid accepted on behalf of the student through the FAFSA process is the responsibility of the student.
- 2) Complete the General Application on the [DePaul Online Scholarship Application](#) website.
 - a) Log into the DePaul Online Scholarship Application using your BlueKey ID and password.
 - b) Complete and submit the General Application.
 - i) Once your application has been completed and submitted successfully, it will be marked with a green checkmark.
 - ii) If it is gray, the application was not submitted successfully; try again.
- 3) After submitting the General Application, you will automatically route to opportunities for which you qualify, and more information is needed.
 - a) If you are recommended for additional scholarships for which more information is needed, you will be able to view a list of opportunities.
 - b) Apply for them by clicking on the blue “Apply” button beside each scholarship. Additional questions or information may be required to complete the application process.
