Description:

This session explores how free, innovative AI tools can support differentiated and inclusive teaching practices, helping educators design more equitable, engaging, and responsive learning experiences for diverse classrooms.

Rooted in the theme Mindful Learning for Tomorrow, the workshop introduces creative platforms that promote accessibility and flexibility in instruction. Tools such as Invideo AI and Veed.io enable the creation of instructional videos with subtitles, voiceovers, and translations—ideal for supporting multilingual learners and visual processors. In addition, Piclumen generates AI-based images from text prompts, offering educators powerful ways to visualize content and support students who benefit from visual learning or alternative forms of expression.

The session includes guided demonstrations, hands-on practice, and ready-to-use resources. Emphasis is placed on using AI purposefully and mindfully to enhance inclusion, amplify student voice, and meet individual learning needs.

Educators will leave with practical strategies and tools to create innovative, differentiated learning environments grounded in well-being, creativity, and intentional teaching.
