Wilderness Adventure in the Boundary Waters Led by Wesley Braker '18, Natural Lands Manager July 14–20, 2024

Sunday, July 14 Depart St. Olaf (LD)

These travelers departing from St. Olaf should meet in the Buntrock Parking lot for a 7 am departure: Wes, Andrew, Bryan, David, Kraig.

On the way north, we'll stop around 7:45 am at <u>555 Cedar Street Parking</u> to pick up: Conrad, Tim, and Paul.

We'll make a pitstop on the way north, and then aim to be at Angry Trout Cafe in Grand Marais for a group lunch by 12:45. Continuing north, we'll have a short tour of the Chik-Wauk Museum at Seagull Lake from Caroline Urban '18 at 4 pm, before heading to Hungry Jack Outfitters (HJO) for check-in and an orientation. Then, it's off to group dinner at 7 pm at Gunflint Lodge. We'll return to HJO to overnight in the bunkhouse.

Monday, July 15 — Thursday, July 18 In the Boundary Waters (BLD)

After a further orientation by staff from Hungry Jack Outfitters, they will then transport us to our nearby entry point. Evening campsites will be chosen by your group leader based on how much progress was made that day and the availability of space at each site.

Friday, July 19 Exit the Boundary Waters, Overnight at Hungry Jack (BLD)

Today we'll exit the BWCA, turn in our gear, have dinner together at 6 pm at Trail Center Restaurant on the Gunflint Trail, and bunk at Hungry Jack.

Saturday, July 20 Return to St. Olaf (B)

Group breakfast at 9 am at Cascade Lodge, and then continue heading south to the drop-off point in the Twin Cities and St. Olaf.
