


Community agreements

Each candidate has signed on to these community agreements to ensure a productive, engaging and respectful environment.

- 1. I am teachable. I am coachable. I am open to learning and growing.
- 2. I am capable of being accountable. My impact matters and I welcome being called in or called out when appropriate.
- 3. There is value in repairing harm. Defensiveness does not serve me, my community, or our collective work.
- 4. A conversation is not accountability. Restorative justice is more than a dialogue. I commit to unlearning harmful behaviors that have been normalized in society and unlearning the ways they show up in my interactions with young people, colleagues, and community members.
- 5. I must learn before I can lead.
- 6. I must love so I can learn.
- 7. Intersectionality is key to all governance.
- 8. I am responsible for my impact and as such, will recognize the privilege I bring into a space including but not limited to my race, gender, ability, socio economic status, immigration status, spoken language, gender expression and sexual orientation.
- 9. I will listen to and prioritize the needs of marginalized youth.
- 10. I will do my own labor to discover when and how it is appropriate for me to stand in solidarity with my fellow New Yorkers based on their identities.
- 11. I will work to be *actively* anti-racist and name the systems that seek to harm students, families, and communities- such as racism, homophobia, transphobia, misogyny, and ableism among others.
- 12. I stand in my power and help New York City's young people stand in theirs.
- 13. I am committed to applying the knowledge I receive to my everyday life in addition to my political work.
