



IMPORTANT HEALTH AND SAFETY INFORMATION

Our [decision tree guidelines](#) have been updated by the county (see below). I am asking all of our Lake families to work with us in preventing the spread of Covid-19, and keeping our school open for in-person learning. Our ability to remain open and prevent the spread relies on all of our staff and families adhering strictly to these guidelines. **If your child or any member of your household does become ill with COVID-19, we ask that you notify us immediately.**

DO NOT SEND YOUR CHILD TO SCHOOL AND CONTACT OUR OFFICE IMMEDIATELY:

- If your child has ANY of the symptoms listed on the decision tree guidelines.
- If your child has been exposed to someone who has tested positive, they should NOT return to in-person learning until given a return date by our nursing staff. This includes exposure to someone living in the home that is positive.
- If you are awaiting a Covid test result for your child, DO NOT SEND YOUR CHILD TO SCHOOL UNTIL YOU HAVE RECEIVED THE NEGATIVE RESULT.

FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE GUIDELINES MAY CAUSE UNNECESSARY QUARANTINES FOR ADDITIONAL STUDENTS

If you are unsure if you should keep your child home, we ask that you err on the side of caution and contact our nursing staff for more guidance. The support of all our families with this protocol will help us keep our bobcats safe and in school learning!
