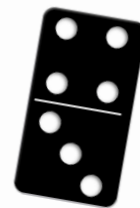

Tick Information - Information for Parents

During warm weather months ticks are more likely to feed on humans. In order to protect you and your child from the diseases that ticks can spread, we are providing you with this resource to learn about ticks and tick prevention.

The health of our students and faculty is very important.

Please do not send your child to school if they are not feeling well or display signs of illness such as cough, vomiting/diarrhea, fever and/or pain. Children should never be medicated for a fever and sent to school.

Please note, if your child is sent home with a fever, vomiting or diarrhea, they are not allowed to return to school the next day.

Children must be free of illness for 24 hours prior to returning to school. They must be fever free, without the use of medication for at least 24 hours before returning to school.

Also, please continue to encourage frequent hand washing for at least 20 seconds as this will decrease the spread of germs. Coughing and sneezing into your elbow should also be encouraged. Continue to remind students to avoid touching their eyes, nose and mouth.

If your child is absent, they must be reported to the school. Please email us at attendance@fredon.org and indicate the reason for the absence.
