Developmental Education Reform

Putting observed practices to work

This activity walks you and your team through a collection of observed practices — good ideas from lean institutions that are making progress in narrowing attainment gaps and increasing student success. Let them serve as a source of inspiration for brainstorms.

Observed practice

<u>Test different models and determine which is most effective</u> for specific institutional needs (e.g., accelerated, co-requisite, or prerequisite models)

To discuss

- What institutional needs aren't currently being addressed?
- What does "good" or "effective" look like?

Observed practice

<u>Consider hiring former high school teachers</u> to serve as developmental education instructors

To discuss

- What additional training, if any, will these instructors need?
- What additional context or information might be helpful to them?

Observed practice

Offer different options for placement, such as multiple measures, and empower advisors to help make placement decisions for students at the margin (note: placement may be governed by state legislation)

To discuss

- What placement options might be most helpful to at-risk students?
- What information might help advisors most? How are at-risk students defined here?

Observed practice

<u>Provide incentives</u> for students to get through developmental education courses (e.g., summer rebates, no- or low-cost summer programs)

To discuss

<u>Invite students to participate</u> in developmental education programming; use <u>positive</u> <u>messaging and motivational space design</u>; provide additional supports for students in these courses (e.g., tutoring, supplemental instruction)

- What developmental education makes the most sense for our students?
- What aspects of developmental education resonate most with students?

Observed practice

If no designated student success course exists, <u>integrate academic success skills into developmental courses</u>

• What are the key Student Learning Objectives (SLOs) for this course?

Explore strategic partnerships with software ,	/ curriculum vendors (e.g., consider
co-creating developmental course content)	

To discuss

- How might technology and software help meet SLOs for this course?
- What curriculum holes might a vendor help with?

Observed practice

If possible, <u>offer personalised developmental education pathways</u> for students

To discuss

- What does personalization mean?
 - Where might personalization intersect with developmental education?
