## **H2 - Bible Verses on Loss and Death**

Bible verses specifically on the topic of the death of a loved one can help put words to the loss you are feeling and help give you closure. • "We are confident, I say, and would prefer to be away from the body and at home with the Lord."

## 2 Corinthians 5:8 (NIV)

In this verse, the apostle Paul expresses that it is not life on earth that those who follow Christ are most concerned with. Instead, it is being with God that brings Christ's followers comfort. It is stating that it would be less preferable to stay on earth than to be with the Lord, which will bring true peace. These words can console those grieving with the knowledge that their loved ones are with the Lord.

• "I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me will live, even though they die; and whoever lives by believing in me will never die. Do you believe this?"

John 11:25-26 (NIV)

Spoken by Jesus, this verse explains that those who believe in Him will never truly die. Jesus is saying that because He was resurrected, we can now enter into eternal heaven with the Lord. This knowledge can be helpful when spoken at a funeral because even though our loved ones may have left us, they are not truly gone. We can find hope and closure in the knowledge that we will be reunited with our loved ones who have passed.

- "For we believe that Jesus died and rose again, and so we believe that God will bring with Jesus those who have fallen asleep in him."
  - 1 Thessalonians 4:14 (NIV)

Here, it is acknowledged that God will not forsake those who have passed, and instead He will take them into heaven with Jesus. Through this statement, peace is given to those attending the funeral, as they are given the belief their loved ones are not alone in death.

The afterlife often seems confusing and vague to those on earth. Each of these verses give those who are feeling the pain of loss more knowledge as to what may happen after death, and gives them something concrete to hold onto.

• From the Old Testament: "The Lord your God in your midst, The Mighty One, will save; He will rejoice over you with gladness, He will quiet you with His love, He will rejoice over you with singing. The Lord your God is with you, He is mighty to save. He will take great delight in you, He will quiet you with His love, He will rejoice over

It can be beneficial to include verses at a funeral that are specifically focusing on those who are left behind and mourning. These types of Bible verses can give a unique form of comfort to loved ones because instead of focusing on the ones who have passed, they are addressing those left behind to grieve. "Blessed are those who mourn, for they will be comforted."
 Matthew 5:4 (NIV)

People who are suffering after the loss of a loved one can find encouragement in Jesus's words here, as He explains that those who mourn are blessed. Jesus states that comfort will be given to those experiencing loss, making this verse an uplifting message to give in your speech.

"The Lord is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit."
 Psalm 34:18 (NIV)

This sentiment from Psalm 34 reminds us that the Lord will console us and bring us out of our pain. It gives us the assurance that those who are mourning will not be forgotten by the Lord, and that He will stand by them through their grief. This reminder that those suffering are not alone is a reassuring message to share at a funeral.

 "'He will wipe away every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death' or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away."
 Revelation 21:4 (NIV)

The comfort of this verse is poignant, as it explains that there will come a time where mourning and grief will no longer exist because God said it will be so. Those suffering loss will find strength in these words as they can trust that there will be a day where the pain will pass. This knowledge has the potential to help alleviate pain and therefore would be a verse worth considering to include at your loved one's funeral.
