

Privacy Policy

Habit Radar: Goals, Focus & Budget

Effective date: July 13, 2026

This Privacy Policy explains how Code Prisma ("we", "us", or "our") handles information when you use the Habit Radar mobile application (the "Application"). Habit Radar helps users track habits, focus sessions, expenses, budgets, challenges, moods, and journal entries. The Application can be used without creating an account.

1. Local-First App Data

Habit names, completion history, streaks, focus sessions, expenses, accounts, budgets, journal entries, moods, preferences, and similar content you create are stored locally on your device. We do not receive this content merely because you use the core Application.

If you choose to export, share, or back up information, the destination service or app you select will process that information under its own terms and privacy policy. You control whether to use those actions.

2. Information Processed by Online Services

The Application may connect to online services for limited purposes. Depending on the features enabled and your location, the following information may be processed:

- Standard connection information, such as IP address, request time, app version, and technical request details, when checking for app configuration or the current privacy policy.
- Advertising identifiers, device information, IP address, consent choices, and app interaction information when Google AdMob advertising is enabled for free users.
- Purchase status, product identifier, purchase token, and related transaction information when Google Play processes or restores Lifetime Access.
- Crash or diagnostic information if platform or device-level diagnostics are enabled.

3. Advertising and Consent

The free version may display advertisements provided by Google AdMob. Google and its advertising partners may process device identifiers, IP address, approximate location derived from IP address, app interactions, and other advertising or measurement information in accordance with their policies and applicable law.

Where required, the Application uses Google's consent tools to request or manage advertising choices before requesting ads. Available choices may include personalized, non-personalized, limited, or technical ad delivery. Purchasing Lifetime Access removes ads requested by the Application. It does not change information already processed before the purchase.

4. Google Play Purchases

Lifetime Access is a non-consumable one-time digital product processed by Google Play Billing. Google processes your payment information. We do not receive or store your full payment card number. The Application receives purchase status and related technical information needed to unlock, acknowledge, and restore the purchase.

5. How We Use Information

Information processed through online services is used to:

- Deliver and maintain Application functionality.
- Retrieve non-personal app settings and the current privacy notice.
- Display and measure ads when advertising is enabled.
- Process, acknowledge, and restore Lifetime Access.
- Protect the Application and services against fraud, abuse, and security threats.
- Comply with legal obligations and enforce applicable terms.

6. Third-Party Services

The Application may use the following categories of third-party services, which process information under their own privacy policies:

- Google Play Services and Google Play Billing for distribution and purchases.
- Google AdMob and Google's User Messaging Platform for advertising and consent management when ads are enabled.
- Hosting and security providers used to deliver remote app configuration and the public privacy policy.

We do not sell your habit, expense, or journal content.

7. Data Retention and Deletion

Local Application data remains on your device until you delete it, clear the Application's storage, or uninstall the Application. Exported copies remain wherever you chose to save or share them until deleted there.

Server access and security logs may be retained for a limited period needed for security, troubleshooting, abuse prevention, and legal compliance. Google retains advertising and purchase information according to Google's policies and your Google account settings.

8. Security

We use reasonable technical and organizational safeguards, including encrypted HTTPS connections for online requests and local storage for core user content. No method of electronic storage or transmission

is completely secure, so absolute security cannot be guaranteed. Protect access to your device, especially if your journal or financial entries are sensitive.

9. Your Choices

- Use core tracking features without creating an account.
- Decline or manage advertising consent choices where available.
- Purchase Lifetime Access to remove ads requested by the Application.
- Export data only when you choose to do so.
- Delete local data by clearing app storage or uninstalling the Application.
- Reset or delete your Android advertising ID through device settings.

10. Children

The Application is intended for a general audience and is not directed to children under 13, or a higher minimum age where required by local law. We do not knowingly collect children's personal information. If you believe a child has provided personal information through an online service, contact us so we can take appropriate action.

11. International Processing

Google and hosting providers may process information in countries other than your country of residence. Where required, service providers use appropriate safeguards for international data transfers.

12. Changes to This Policy

We may update this Privacy Policy to reflect changes to the Application, service providers, legal requirements, or data practices. The current policy is available inside the Application and at the public URL supplied in the Google Play listing. We will update the effective date when the policy changes.
