- Veronica cofounder and director , cancer survivor, lost her daughter; incorporates into her performance as a Latin dancer, performer
- John Haligan (sic), the Ryan Story presentation: lost his son to suicide, talks about how to prevent and support
- Working to get price points and open to ideas or suggestions on who people would like to see
 - Discussion on different levels of appropriateness of different topics and how does the PTO decide on what comes in versus what does not
 - Cost effectiveness of having vendors for specific grades versus all grades
 - Themes: core values, polling teachers and Mrs Rubino
- Able to bring back Challenge Day for 8th graders via grant (not PTO sponsored)
 - Full day experience where they meet in small groups, learn about who they are, identities, team building and fun. Powerful experience.
 - May need parental volunteers; will know more as we get closer. Happens in December

School Supplies: Denise E

- Share numbers for last years
- Every box is \$7 box, looking for a commitment at this point; start talking to the teams January and February, submit lists by April and then pre-order supplies
- A few years back did some research to see if there was any other company that was less expensive/brought in more money but did not find anything
 - One piece of negative feedback was the company blasted out emails to families; so rep has been told not to do that

Fundraising: Kate G

- Dues campaign/new procedures update, new way of collecting donations; found a vendor called Give Butter; can give any way that works for families
 - 5 checks, all others given through Give Butter
 - Anyone who donates through the online site will get an email for tax purposes
 - In order to be more friendly to the environment, less paper and more electronic forms
- Restaurant nights - Kate McLoed
 - Talk to Fat Larry's - could do a dine out on 9/29 from 12:30-4:30; 20%
 - Paperwork in for Mandarin, just waiting to hear back
- Charleston Wrap - 10/16 - 12/4/23
 - Passive fundraiser; online gifts/holiday site - homegoods, towels, wrapping paper, email goes out to let parents know, officially launch in October
- Calareso's - October

- Not doing the fundraisers with middle school or high schools, elementary only
- Budgeted for a good amount of money for that but can reallocate for that; should be fine based on money that comes in

- Update on staff luncheon
 - Day before first day; staff very appreciative
- Update on Fall Family Fun Night
 - Free event
 - Well attended
 - New last year in this format
- School supplies in office
 - PTO purchases school supplies for students who may not otherwise have them; Mrs Finnegan has a filing cabinet for the supplies and gave Kate a list of what was running low and then Mrs F puts together kits
 - Keep supplies maintained throughout the year
- Fall staff room restock, lobby decorating
 - Sign up genius to families to look to get donations to stock the staff room
 - Did that for the first time last year
 - Feedback has been good from families who want to contribute or help but cannot come to Parker for other events
 - Decorate the lobby for fall; PTO has 3 seasons of decorations: fall, winter theme, spring

 - Thank you to all the families who have signed up to help out this year
 - Link will go out again via email for more volunteers for specific jobs, as well as for on call volunteers
