Essential Question: Can one ceramic piece capture a weekend?

Purpose: Create a work of ceramic art that is a personal response to the NYC field trip

**Something to do with maps and roads**, subways, other transit that we took and how that line/those lines might be interesting--think about how this might affect the surface of a piece of ceramic.

**Pattern or texture studies** based on objects or patterns seen in the city and put on a shaped piece of your choice.

A form that **includes a message** about something you saw during your stay in NYC (trash, homelessness, fashion, etc)

**An unusual view** spotted somewhere in the city. No simple skylines allowed. Photo references and sketches mandatory.

**Architecture Abstraction**--you took lots of photos, now find an interesting one to abstract(simplify, multiply, etc). (Look at <a href="NYC abstractions">NYC abstractions</a> for ideas if needed--use your own images, of course.)

A form that is **inspired by food** you had in NYC

You MUST have planning sketches that you show me before you start.

## Assessment to follow, yet remember these guidelines.

- 4= Exceeds: WOW! This is INCREDIBLE!!! You've truly stretched yourself in concept and/or technical aspects.
- 3= Meets: Good job! All directions are followed and the work is good.
- 2= Partially Meets: Fair job. Some directions are not followed, while some areas look good.
- 1= Does Not Meet: Directions not followed.
