Most rubber washers have a life of 7 to 10 years. Water can begin circulation when damaged.

The only way to say the rubber washer is no longer operating is to start the shower head and examine the structure. If the rubber washer is used, it must be changed. Rubber washers are cost-effective and quite readily available in most hardware stores. Placing a rubber washer does not need prior assessment with a plumber and can be easily done by a person, as long as this person knows how to start the shower head. If the rubber washer is unchanged and efficient, the next step will be to check if the issue is not caused by the internal water supply valves. These valves lead to controlling the circulation of water in the shower head. Sometimes they can loosen or rust. It must be assured that they are not damaged. In some cases, the circulation may be due to the buildup of mineral salt and other waste in the shower head. To remove minerals and waste, it must be separated and taken apart. To get rid of calcium and lime deposits, there are commercial cleaning products in which to dip the shower head. Another option is to dip the shower head in white vinegar for 2 to 4 hours to remove calcium deposits. Sometimes the leak is due to holes around the shower head. Rust could be involved here. This may need uncomplicated of a front metal plate, putty or sealing tape. Although shower heads usually do not cause problems, servicing is necessary to avoid leaking. It is important to clean it regularly to avoid calcium accumulation, rust and other waste. Always replace defective parts before they can cause further damage.
