

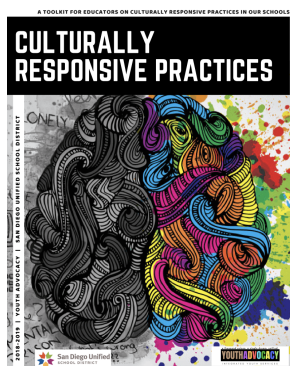

This toolkit created by the SDUSD Youth Advocacy department includes both a framework for culturally responsive education and strategies to use in classrooms.



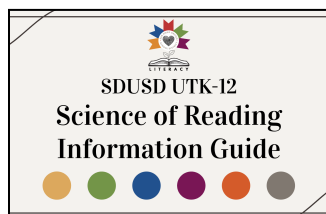
