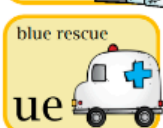
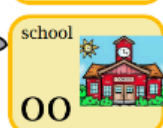

A **Closed** syllable has one short vowel (marked with a breve), and is followed by one or more consonants.

## Mark closed syllable exception

chīld

kīnd

scōld

jōlt

mōst

A **Closed Syllable Exception** has a long vowel sound (marked with a macron), instead of the expected short vowel sound.

## Mark vowel-consonant-e syllable

cāme

ēve

smīle

A **Vowel-Consonant-e** syllable has one long vowel (marked with a macron), followed by one consonant followed by a silent "e" (marked with slash).

## Mark vowel-consonant-e exception

gīve

ōlive

hăve

līve

A **Vowel-Consonant-e Exception** has a short vowel sound (marked with a breve), instead of the expected long vowel sound.

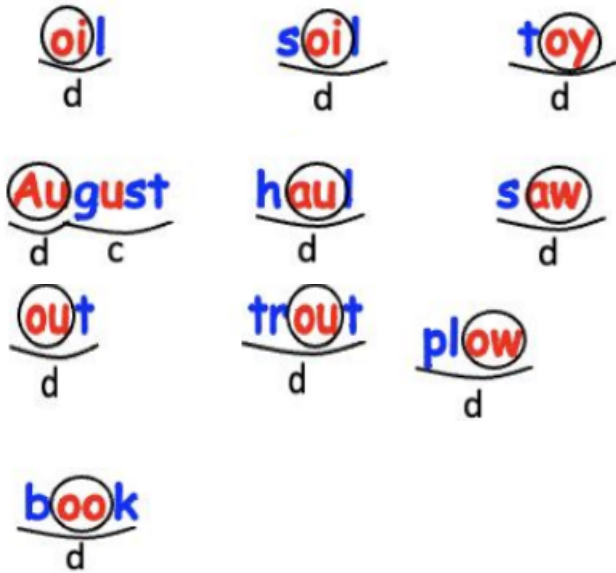

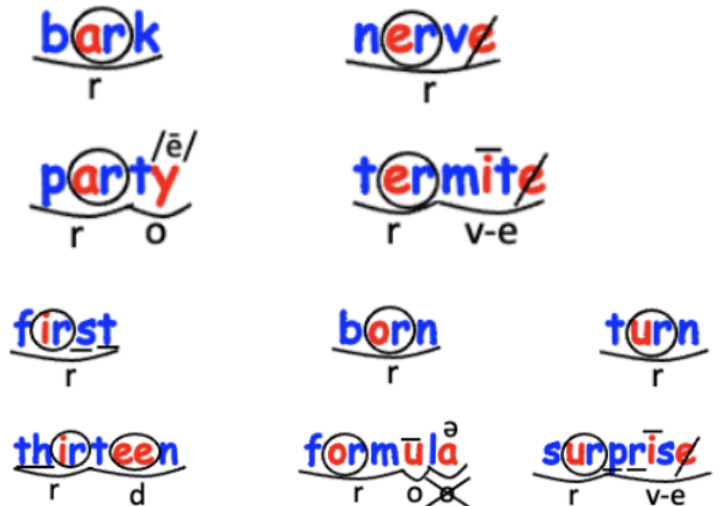
## Mark "D" syllable

The two vowels work as a team and make the **Double Vowel Syllable**.



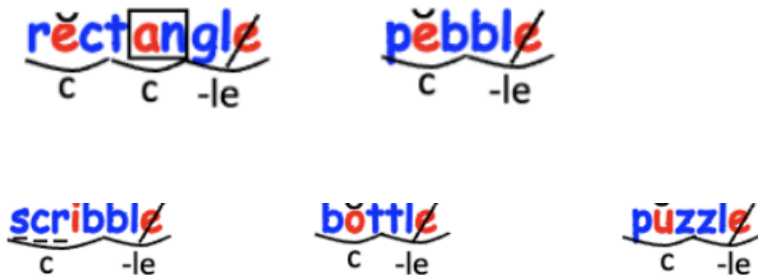
## Mark r-controlled syllables

When "r" follows the vowel, the "r" **controls** the sound of the vowel. The vowel is not short or long.



## Mark consonant-le syllable

In **consonant-le syllable exception** words ending in **stle**, both the **t** and the **e** are silent and the four letters **stle** are read as /sl/.
