All applications received by the deadline will be reviewed and judged by AHS Business Education Teachers and Metrum Community Credit Union personnel in order to choose *one* winning application.

- 3. This scholarship award will be issued for the 2022/2023 school year.
- 4. Student must have completed or be currently enrolled in the Personal Finance or CE Personal Finance course at Arapahoe High School.



#### REQUIREMENTS

This scholarship offered by Metrum Community Credit Union is a one-year scholarship available to a senior graduating from Arapahoe High School and enrolling to an institution of higher learning after graduation.

<u>All</u> materials must be included, as listed. No exceptions will be made. Application should consist of all required materials.

Application form <u>must be complete</u>. (Typed or computer generated is preferred)

- 1. Essay from applicant. In this essay the student should discuss their background, their college and career goals, and why they believe the financial education they received in the Personal Finance class is important to their future. Essay must be typed and limited to two pages (double spaced). Essay must include student name and birth date in a header on each page for identification purposes.
- 2. Resume. This should be typed and submitted on a document, not included within body of applicant's essay. This should list all extracurricular activities, community activities, volunteer work, honors, offices held and, your most recent cumulative GPA. For any volunteer activities, list the name of the organization and the number of hours, weeks and years that you volunteered. If you worked, list the company, hours per week and length of time.
