Event Check in will run from 7:30am-8:15am, I plan to be at the gate area so you do not have to walk all the way back to your car. : If you fail to check in by 8:15am you will forfeit your spot to any potential waitlister on site.

Round 1 will start at 8:30 sharp, and two minutes are called out at 8:28am.

After the final card is submitted we will have a 1 hour lunch break then start round 2.

Starting holes for round 1 will be posted on our PDGA event Page [HERE](#) Thursday the 2nd at approximately 7pm, and again on this exact page with round 2 starting holes(Sorted by Score)

Payouts this year will be handled on-site with Disc Revolution. If you are in the top 25% of your division, stick around after round 2 to redeem your winnings. I will have payouts posted during the lunch hour on my check in table, since that is when I will have final player counts and payout totals completely calculated.

This is a PDGA B-Tier Event, all PDGA rules will be followed including those regarding alcohol consumption, marijuana use, and that you can not have a dog with you during the course of play.
