How Can a Student Be Identified as College Ready?

A student is considered *college-ready* if they meet **one or more** of these criteria:

- **ACT:** Composite score of **20 or higher** (highest single administration score).
 - **SAT:** Total score of **1040 or higher** (highest single administration score).
 - **AP:** Score of **3 or higher** on any Advanced Placement exam.
 - **Dual Enrollment:** Completion of **6 or more college credit hours** with a grade of **C or higher** in approved courses.

How Can a Student Be Identified as Career Ready?

A student is considered *career-ready* if they meet **one or more** of these criteria:

- **CTE Completer** + earn a **national/state industry credential**.
 - **WIN SC Career Ready Test:** Earn a **Level 3 Credential or higher**.
 - **ASVAB:** Earn a score of **31 or higher**.
 - **Work-Based Learning:** Successfully complete a state-approved evaluation, including:
 - Training agreement with clear objectives and at least **40 hours** of practical experience.
 - Placement aligned with the student's **IGP career goal**.
 - Industry evaluation based on world-class skills from the **Profile of the SC Graduate**.
 - Completion of at least **one unit** in the related career pathway.
 - **SC Employability Credential:** Students with disabilities may qualify by completing the **South Carolina High School Employability Credential** program as outlined in their IEP.
