Curriculum Topics:

CKLA:

- ★ Students will finish Unit 8: Native Americans.
- ★ Students will prepare for their end of unit assessment which is on Monday, June 2.

ELC:

- ★ Students will work on finalizing their persuasive speeches.
- ★ Students will continue reading their novels and studying the science fiction genre.
- ★ Students will do their Word study on Greek roots biblio, ast(ro), cycl(o).

Math 5:

- ★ Students will draw symmetric figures using distance and angle measures from the line of symmetry.
- ★ Students will draw symmetric figures on the coordinate plane.
- ★ Students will plot data on line graphs and analyze trends.
- ★ Students will use coordinate systems to solve real-world problems.

Math 5/6:

- ★ Students will take a mid-module 6 assessment
- ★ Students will be given a data set, and determine the median of the data.
- ★ Students will be given a set of data, and describe how the data might have been collected and the unit of measurement for observations in a data set.
- ★ Students will calculate the median of the data and describe the variability in the data by calculating the interquartile range.
