SOCIAL INCLUSION

IVAIGO conducts creative thinking, visual arts, reading activities, and AI training, targeting marginalized communities and enabling them to gain essential skills and confidence.

Additionally, IVAIGO offers Lithuanian language courses to refugees and migrants, facilitating their integration into society and providing opportunities for social and cultural adaptation. The organization actively participates in Erasmus+ projects to promote inclusion:
