● **Does this TA meet or beat COLA?**

- Did California fund COLA?
- Historically, do we ever get close to COLA?
- How does this TA compare on salary increases with other locals?
- How did school funding change on June 30?
- Is the TA only about salary?
- What is our role in saying how this money is spent?
- Can Rep Council vote to not recommend?
- What happens if Rep Council does not recommend?

We will present to you factual information on historical tentative agreements, current budgetary conditions, and important questions that might inform your decision to support this tentative agreement or not.

Our presentation will compare the TA to the actual COLA and additional monies FUSD received from the state. **You deserve to have this information to make an informed decision.**
