Week 4 Activity - Basic Web Research

This week you will have the opportunity to complete some basic web research. You will be using Google and a notepad website that will allow you to download basic text and publish it to the class Padlet. All the links are below. 3rd and 4th Grades will be publishing to separate Padlets and the 5th grade activity will only be available in Google Classroom. In addition to the brief instructions below, I have recorded a video walk-through to make things easier. Also, if anyone is interested, I added a video at the bottom showing how ice cream sandwiches are made in a factory. Check it out, it's pretty neat.

Directions:

Answer the two questions below and record the URL or web address of the website where you found each answer. Just typing "Google" or "Google.com" is not acceptable for the URL. Google doesn't publish information; it finds information from other sources and makes it easier for users to find. Also, you shouldn't type in the entire question into a Google search. Google does not search words like "the," or "of," or "and." Search only the words that I have highlighted, which we will call the "search terms." Once you find the answer, you will type it and the URL in the online notepad that I have linked to below. Please see the walk-through video for the proper procedure.


