



NVHS Parking Lot Policy

New Vista has the great fortune to be located at the foot of the Flatirons and directly across from the University of Colorado. This location also comes with limited parking options. It is an expectation that students who drive to New Vista purchase a parking permit to park in our student lot. To ensure consistency and fairness in this expectation, it is necessary to develop a policy that applies to all students who choose to park in the student lot without purchasing a permit.

After our lottery process is complete, all New Vista students allowed to park in the student lot must purchase a parking permit. Students can pay online or at the front desk. Students can find the lottery

**A student parking permit is valid only for the designated student spots. Students should not park in any spot that is not numbered. Staff have different color parking permits. We check both lots frequently for violators.*

If not chosen in the lottery to have a spot each semester, students will need to find their parking off-street in the neighborhood. Please be prepared to have to walk a few blocks to make it into school on time.

As part of the parking permit agreement, students sign off that they understand that parking in the following spaces is not permitted and is also subject to the consequences listed below:

- Parking spaces with visitor signs
- Handicap parking spaces
- Parking spaces with signs for school staff
- Parking spaces without numbers or in the loop in front of the building
- **No Loitering:** Loitering in parked vehicles during school hours is strictly prohibited.

To implement a clear and equitable parking policy, the following consequences will be put in place for any student who chooses not to follow New Vista's expectations that students 1) Purchase and Display a Permit, 2) Do not park in specially labeled spots, 3) Park only in student designated spaces (these are marked with numbers)

Parking in a Handicap Spot	• Warning • Student will be asked to move their car • Student will sign a copy of this policy and it will be emailed home to parents.	A \$50 fine per day/incident will be added to the student's RevTrack account. This is in alignment with city expectations and is also reflective of our school's focus on equity.	
Parking in a visitor spot or in the loop in front of the school	• Warning • Student will be asked to move their car • Student will sign a copy of this policy and it will be emailed home to parents.	A \$10 fine per day/incident will be added to the student's RevTrack account
