

Important Registration Information for Grade 9 Students Entering Grade 10

Grade 9 students will be choosing their courses before **March Break**. Please carefully read the Powerpoint for Grade 9 students, the information sheet and the instructions on how to select courses using the Powerschool student/parent portal. The registration screens will be closed until that time.

Math

The recommendations of the Grade 9 Math teachers will be pre-chosen for all students. We strongly suggest that students follow the recommendation of their math teacher for the best chance of success in the Grade 10 program. ****Students will be unable to change the math selection on their own.

English

English Teachers will also be sending recommendation forms home with students. English 10 Plus will be recommended to students that they feel can benefit from a full year English 10 course. English 10 Plus will be pre-chosen for those students who are recommended by their teacher. ****Students will be unable to change the English 10 Plus selection on their own.

Science

Science 10 will be prechosen for students taking Math 10.

Science 10 A/B will be prechosen for students taking Math @Work 10 or Math Essentials 10

If any parent wishes to go against the recommendation, for Math and English, and have their child take a different course, the parent is asked to return the signed form to the Guidance Office by Monday, March 2, 2026 and we will make the change.

Please note that Resource and additional Math supports will not be available if a student disregards the recommendation of the Math & English teachers. Any student that does not pass Math 9 will be placed in Math Essentials 10 regardless of their choice. **If they are successful in Math Essentials 10, there will be an opportunity to take a higher level Math 10 in Grade 11 if they wish.**
