- 3. **School Update**
 - **Ukrainian Students (Immersive School)** A few children have found permanent homes and are now moving to another schools, 4 families, ~10 children are moving schools soon.
 - **<u>Pre-Kindergarten Program (YMCA)</u>** In the final phase of inspection. When final inspections are completed, they will be preparing to open their operation.
 - **Kinderstart Program** Began February 24, next dates March 31, April 21, May 12, and June 2 on reserve in case of a cancelation
 - **Grade 6 ICF Program** Parent info session was held on february 22, Registration on February 28. We have not received confirmation of numbers yet. Registration is currently open, numbers for enrollment have not been shared with admin yet.
 - **Teacher appreciation day** Thank you so much for the lovely treats. The children really enjoyed filling the bulletin board with stickies complimenting their teachers. The bulletin board was a bit hit with students and a positive experience.
 - **Pink Shirt Day** was interrupted by a storm day but we proceeded with a flood of pink and kindness activities throughout the building the day after.
 - **Janeway Day** Again was missed due to the storm, but we did participate with online donations.
 - 100th Day was also impacted due to the snowstorms, but went ahead during the week of Feb 13-17th.
