



What do we mean by PedTech?

Edtech is when we're thinking about technology that focuses on systems and on processes. And in those kinds of conversations, we're often talking about pedagogy - things that can be replicated a bit like a recipe for making a cake, they're steps that we can go through to do something effectively for a given and known outcome. Petech turns that on its head slightly, with Pedtech we're thinking about why we're doing what we're doing. It's why we're making that cake. So here we're thinking about pedagogical intentions, and those are the deep held, implicit beliefs we have about what makes good learning, what it is to be a learner. About what it is to teach and to be a teacher and all of those wonderful things, but our personal views on those. Those shape why we're using that technology for that end. So if we're thinking about Edtech, as like the shoe that goes around the foot, and the foot is the technology and Edtech is the shoe. Pedtech is the leg that makes that foot move in the first place.
