

FAQ for Okie Love of Learners

1. How do I become an official member of Okie Love of Learners? You are an official member of Okie Love of Learners when your child is registered and attends one of our classes.

2. What is the fee for membership? There is no membership fee associated with Okie Love of Learners. There is a facility/insurance/supply fee required from each family who attends classes at Okie Love of Learners.

3. Who can teach at Okie Love of Learners? Anyone who is willing to offer a class. If there is a class that you would like to offer to your children or others, simply post the information on the BAND app to see if there is interest. Because there are several different faiths represented in Okie Love of Learners and the curriculum used in each class is chosen by the teachers, parents should visit with individual teachers with questions concerning material to be covered in class.

All classes are taught by parents in our group unless otherwise noted.

4. Who can join Okie Love of Learners? Any family who is interested in building relationships with other families. This is a family group. A parent should plan to attend with the children.

5. Does my child need to be in class from 9-4? It is not necessary to enroll in classes for the entire day. Enroll in only the desired classes.

6. Will Okie Love of Learners organize field trips? We have had many organized field trips! More would be better! If you have an idea, please post it on the BAND app.

7. What are some of the opportunities to serve Okie Love of Learners? As is the case with any organization, volunteers are needed and much appreciated. While service is not required, it will be more enjoyable for everyone if we all work together. Everyone should serve in the area that

they feel best suited: teaching, organizing field trips, suggesting a picnic at the park, taking a mom out for coffee. With any group, cleaning up after everyone is always a big job. We hope that serving this group will be enjoyable and rewarding.

8. How is the leadership of Okie Love of Learners structured? There is no leadership board. Okie Love of Learners belongs to the membership. There is a church liaison to whom church-related questions should be addressed. The creators of Okie Love of Learners simply desire to serve the teachers and parents by providing a place to come together for learning. Teachers will have the freedom and authority to govern their classes as they decide. Parents should visit with each teacher about their individual beliefs and class policies.

9. Why are there no enrollment or communication features on the website?

Currently, there are no administrative costs associated with Okie Love of Learners. In an effort to keep this group affordable, we use a free website service and the BAND app for communication.
