For Projects

We request that presentations be less than 12 minutes, and have two distinct parts, clearly separated by a divider slide*:

- **Science Discussion** - Please share what you're up to, with a focus on new science. (*Longer-running projects, please be sure to differentiate from past talks, particularly last year's)
- **BOINC Discussion** - Please discuss how the project was enabled by BOINC. And where relevant, please discuss BOINC constraints – e.g. what you could do if BOINC had specific new features, or resolved specific issues. - *This will help to guide community discussion later in the workshop*

(*The divider slide will enable us to post the science and BOINC discussions to YouTube separately, following the event - subject of course to your permission. We hope these will be useful outreach assets, as has been the case for [talks from the prior workshop.](#))
