Introduction:

AP Human Geography is a course that is *laden* with a *voluminous* amount of vocabulary terms that are at a *collegiate* level. Understanding these terms in depth will help you succeed in both the multiple choice and free response sections of the exam.

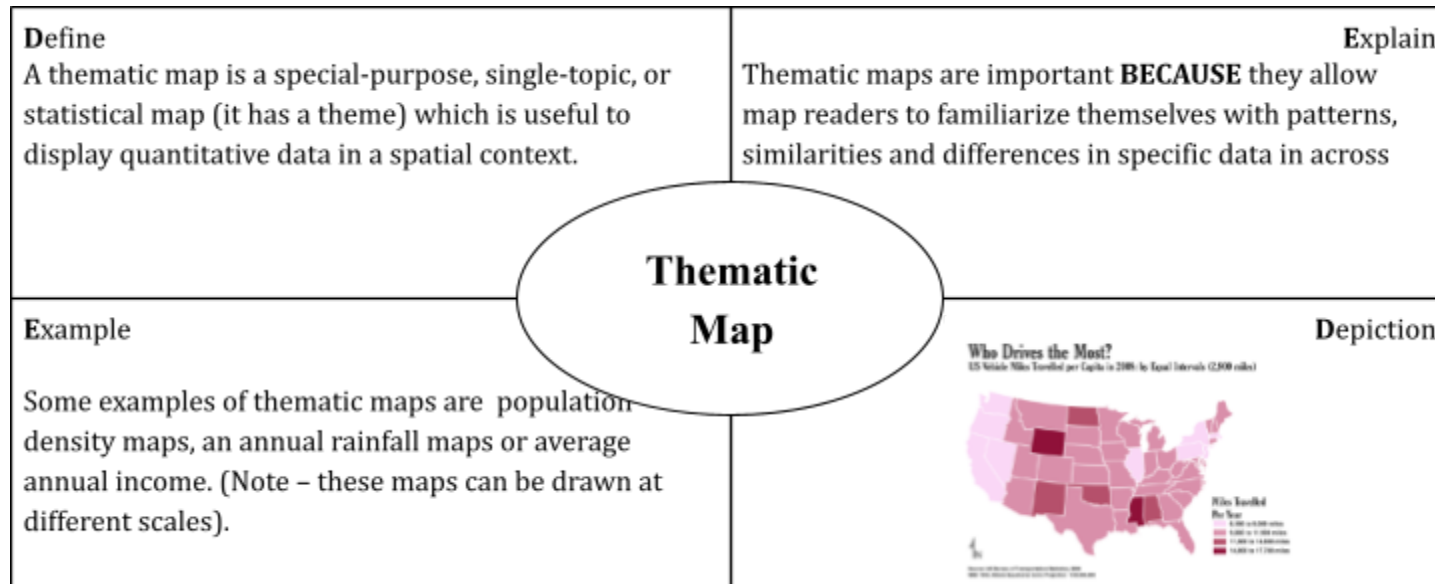
- Definition of the term.

- Depiction/Drawing a visual representation of the term.

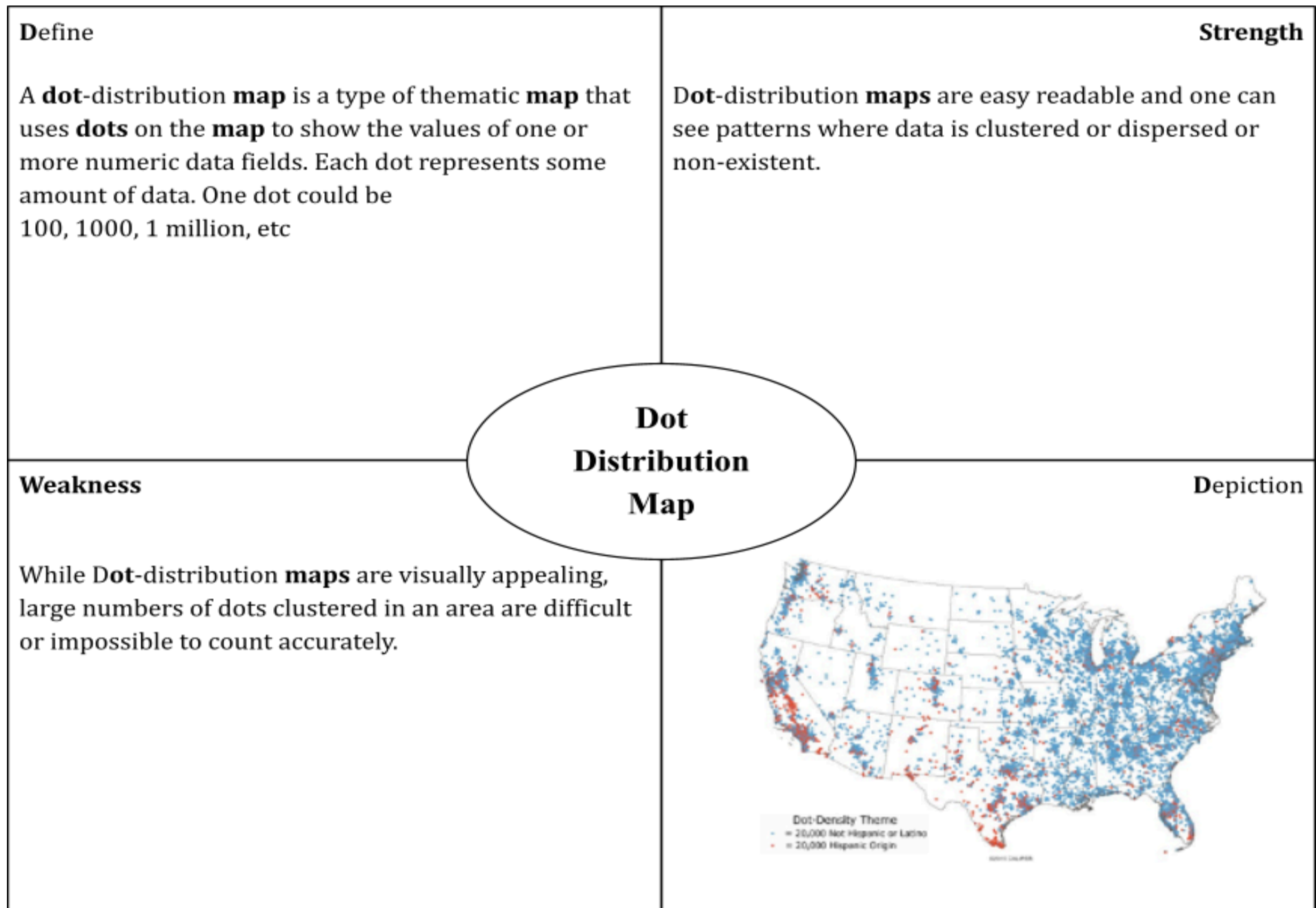
Sometimes we might ask you other questions like

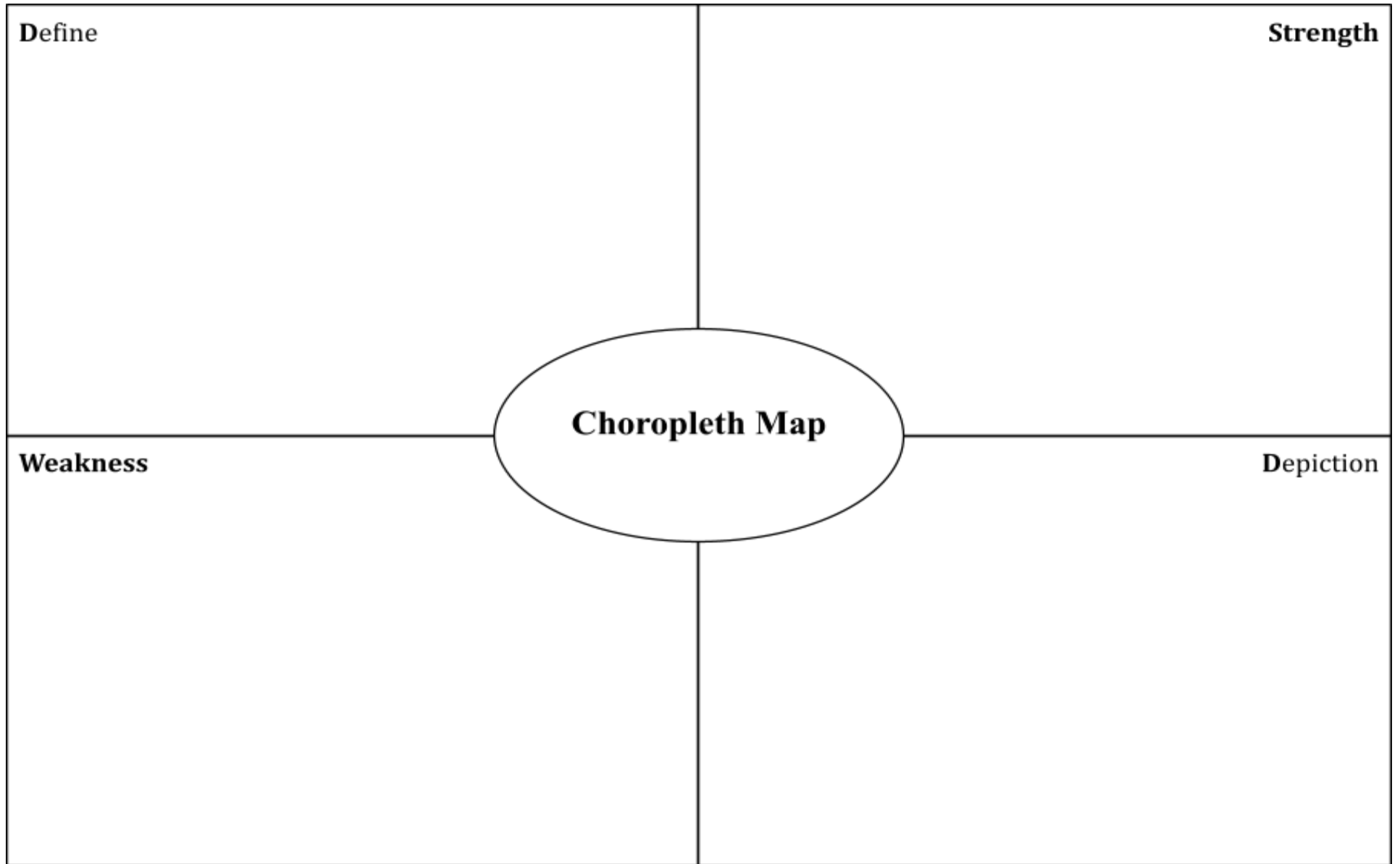
- Strengths of the term/concept/model/map
- Weaknesses of the term/concept/model/map

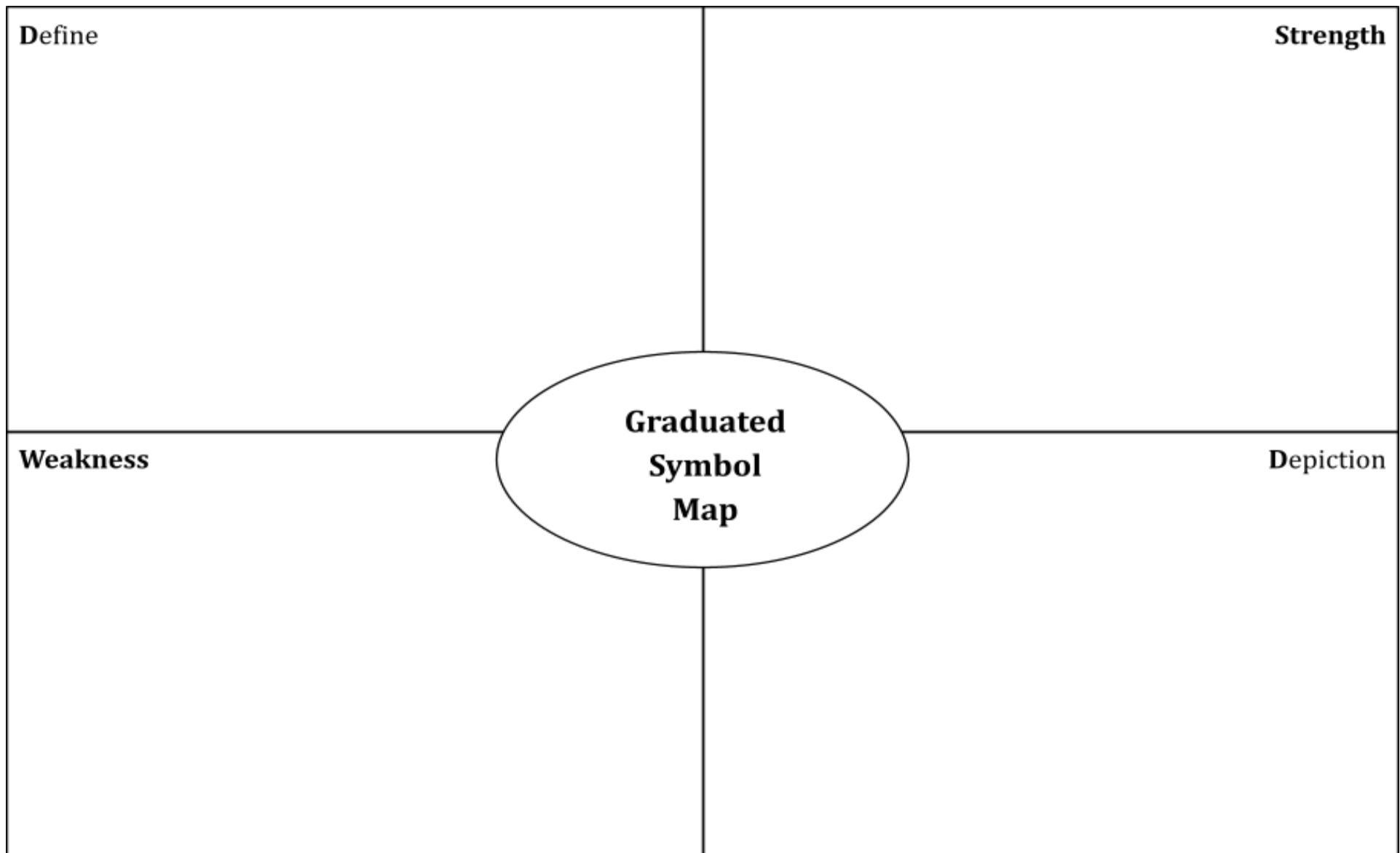
