- III. Guest Speaker: Andy Barnes, Assistant Executive Director, WIAA
 - -Exec mtg 4/23
 - -Rep voting 4/9-4/19 amendments hot topics...legal implications of amendments, working through all that, bottom line WIAA will follow state law, these type of thing may become the norm
 - Exec board-definition of league (variety of size), representation of seeding committees. Now each league gets 1 rep but may be 1 rep 4 when other leagues have many more teams...proposal for 2 reps for each dist? Leagues chose the rep. some chose coaches, some want Ads/admin. Can WIAA provide criteria, don't want to dictate since all sports are different, may ask for insight from ISA/coaches. Some meet weekly, some spreadsheets. They want to ask what they are doing not tell what to do. Basketball looking less at RPI for seeding, how teams doing later in season and how they are doing post season. Looking for feedback. Can't worry about the optics. Nalin-WIAA doesn't want to put parameters on it? Any discussion on having those with teams in the meeting remove themselves when it comes to final voting? Corey- softball is talking about this. They had coaches with teams in avoiding certain teams. Andy-yes WIAA wants give space for each sport, not direction given but Cindy looking into it. Trying to get consistency. As for recusing themselves that may be hard, some groups have asked them to remove for discussion, hard when you don't know who will be in the running until the end, a lot to ask of people to give so much then not voting. Replace with someone new is hard at the end. Jens- can WIAA dictate to districts there must be transparency in selecting reps? Some are chosen by ADs Andy- meeting with district Ads and will talk

about it. Suzzanne- Ads with no idea are on committee and no one speaks up since they don't know. Important to know how committees are selected. Needs to be people/coaches who know about sport. Rob- heard committee had replacements that didn't know anything. Jens- AD turn over is too much so wants to push Andy- if you see people not attending, not reping league or not participating let WIAA know. They can have them make a switch. Mike-a summary about how teams are doing instead of RPI would be great. Andy-if WIAA knows the criteria the committees are using would hep them explain it to anyone. Tawnya- if each meeting did a follow up email after meetings sent to WIAA Nalin- do we ask our larger group Andy- WIAA would lie more info on who, metrics, criteria, standards... Meet with league presidents in June and can start that conversation then on choosing. Corey- hard to seed areas far away that you may never have seen. Can go to AD and tell them team needs to travel to see some teams they may have not seen. Andy-seeding committees have done a good job and it has turned out for the most part correctly. Perfect?...no but good NFHS went through brackets in basketball looks like most seeing was good in the end, seed vs final finish Pat -seeding looked good vs final standing in basketball Corey- trying to avoid seeding to eliminate good teams in first round. Andy-good feedback will take back to Cindy -Allocations-done with 2 week, will have them out soon to get feedback, any missed. Exec board approve next Sunday will be up next Monday. More tournaments at 1A/1B may be separate from 2A/B -allocation cunt issue led to allocation committee to look at how allocations are figured and entire allocation process. Reviewing what other states do. Expansion of tournaments is a choice but has to balance with finances. Committee looking at post season. Jens on committee and will bring feedback from this group. 1 rep from every

-Basketball and other sports-protesting procedures...regular season and post season ...each work differently. Want to help coaches understand. Regular season misapplication of rule not opinion on play or call. Wrong procedure used. Misapplication of rule. Schools have 24hrs to protest to WIAA then Assistant reviews. Did it happen, then turned back to league to decide what to do. Up to league what to do, WIAA just review protest. Post season must be protested immediately, contest must stop immediately to incorrect action or application, need to reach out to games committee right then, decision made by games committee then game resumes. Once games resume protest no longer matters. Jens – need a signal to do that, it is hard to do. Andy-WIAA needs to review with AD and during rules committee. Game should not start until game manger says game may resume once games committee has made decision. Will make sure it is in the rules. Nalin- is that in the rules clinic? Regular season protest vs post season

protests Rob- WIAA member on rules committee? Andy rather not since they interpret rules but happens. WIAA wants to available to games committee but doesn't need to be on it.

-update from Justin transfer committee, amendment looks to pass, working with final forms to have tracking, they have started to work on that. Seem positive. Mark- will it go through middle school Andy- yes Mark- middles school all star games Andy- coaches for All Star middle school could impact transfers, working with middle schools is hard. WIAA has struggles with middles schools as they don't always follow rules. Tracking all student eligible for high school sports will be tracked. They will have a number for each student so they can easily track and se history. Lori- can that be in Final forms for parents to see. Andy – we can look into that Mark-currently only consequence is to the student not the coach? Andy- coach and school are not invitation but if school/ coach recruits there can be penalties to school/coach Cierra- how often does league committee say no and WIAA says yes Andy- not sure but not high percentage, Justin or Jene can answer

- -Mark- transfer...will there be implication for McKinney Vinto Andy- ask Cindy or Justin, Understanding McKinney/Vinto doesn't guarantee sports eligibility. Mick, Justin have met with OSPI and know how that impacts eligibility
- -Emily- girls basketball-major violence issue, rule unclear but old rule very clear. Why fighting rule went away? Ended up with 1 game suspension for girls who caused violence (hospitalization/concussion) and these who left the bench. How do we hold accountable. Why did fighting rule go away. Andy- original rule was over used, then 20% rule was added. Thought it was deterred but it didn't. Decided to leave it up to schools. Schools/leagues have different standards and consequences. WIAA can't force more although they wish they could, they don't have the authority.

- Communicate to your coaches, information from the WIAA and/or your national sport's association.
- Provide feedback to the WIAA regarding any issues related to your sport that may need immediate or long-term solutions.
- Provide networking opportunities for your sport group
- Provide educational clock hour opportunities for your coaches
- Are the coaches in your sport group staying in compliance with coaching education requirements? (this is a WIAA concern)

WSCA is a 501c-6 not tax write off, Boys Basketball is 501c-3 but it is quite a process, Nalin happy help.
