Inventory

Cables are found in milk crate

- 1 speaker (recommend the Yorkville because it has two inputs)
- 1 power cable for speaker
- 1 Shure microphone
- 1 XLR cable to connect microphone to speaker
- 1 1/8" minijack to XLR to connect iPod directly to speaker

Procedure

- 1. Ensure the speaker is turned off and output levels set to low
- 2. Connect all cables
- 3. Turn on speaker
- 4. Slowly raise output volume

Advanced

This setup is used when several inputs are used, like a panel event. We assume you know what you're doing in this case, but please get permission from NetSquared Vancouver before you book the full setup with the mixing board, both speakers, and all the other jazz.
