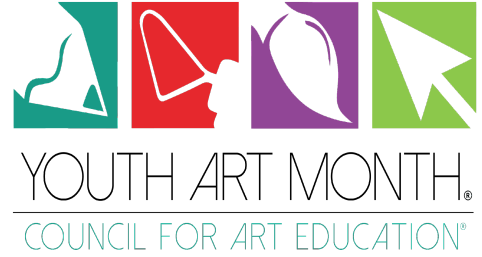

WHEREAS, in support of Youth Art Month, the Washington Art Education Association coordinates a contest in which students create a design based on the annual theme; the winning designs are made into flags, which are displayed and recognized at the National Art Education Association Convention; and

WHEREAS, Youth Art Month aims to increase community understanding and interest in art and visual art education through involvement in art exhibits, workshops, and other creative ventures; and

WHEREAS, multiple national leaders have acknowledged the necessity of including visual art experiences in all students' education; and

WHEREAS, I/We commend all those who advocate for youth art and educators throughout our state and encourage people to support visual art programs in our schools;
