Barn School 2026: Registration Guidelines

Step 1 - We have provided class descriptions, the class schedule, and instructor bios on our website at www.indianladderfarms.com/barn-school/.

Step 2 - Purchase your classes on www.shopindianladderfarms.com, beginning **February 1st, 2026 at 10am**. Pay for your selected classes and print the receipt for your tax records.

Step 3 - Our Education Program Coordinator will send the final paperwork to you via email. Please **fill out and submit this form** at your earliest convenience. All paperwork must be completed to finish the registration process.

SOLD OUT CLASSES/THE WAITLIST:

Only use this once you have confirmed there are no remaining openings in the class you want to register for.

Once a class has sold out, you can add your name to the waitlist. Your placement on the waitlist will correlate with the time and date the form is received. To be placed on the waitlist, please fill out the Google Form link provided in the description of the class on our online store. ***The waitlist for each class will open when the session becomes full.***

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Barn School 2026: Policy & Registration Guidelines

REFUNDS:

Due to high demand for this program, we **do not offer refunds** and classes **may not be transferred to another name.**

CANCELED CLASSES:

We do not like to cancel any sessions; however, each session must be self-supporting. We have established a minimum enrollment number and **must cancel any sessions that do not meet this minimum**. If we must cancel a session you registered for we will contact you regarding other available sessions.

PRE-CLASS EMAIL:

You will receive a reminder email *two weeks* before your child's class starts.

DROPPING OFF & PICKING UP:

For safety reasons, drop-offs and pick-ups will be done **inside the Farm Store**. Please ***do not* drop participants off *before* classes begin or at any location other than the Farm Store**. You will need to sign your child in and out daily. If someone else is picking up your child, please notify our staff with the name of the individual *prior* to the class session.

WEATHER & INSECTS:

Participants must be ready for farm activities, even in the rain and heat! **Please note that refunds are not available due to bad weather.**

Wear a raincoat, bring a hat, and apply sunscreen and insect repellent before arriving. Staff members *cannot* assist with application of sunscreen and insect repellent. Be sure to check for ticks after class! For more information on ticks, visit www.albanycounty.com/health/lyme.aspx.

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BREAK OPTION: *No lunch is served by ILF, you must pack your own lunch.*

If your child attends both the morning and afternoon classes, they will have an hour-long break (12pm - 1pm) between sessions. If you are unable to pick up your child during this break, you must purchase the *Break Option* which covers childcare between classes. **We do not provide lunch, so please pack lunches for your child.** There will be a refrigerator available for them to keep their food fresh. The Break Option costs an additional \$75 per week. If you want to purchase this option, please visit www.shopindianladderfarms.com to enroll for the week of your child's class(es).

REFRESHMENTS:

Each day during the session of the class, Barn School will provide each participant with one of our beloved ciders, doughnuts and a choice of cold water or lemonade, as a mid-morning or mid-afternoon snack. If your child has any dietary restrictions or needs additional or substitute snacks, please pack them accordingly. We have refrigeration facilities for any cold items. All participants are advised to bring their water bottles and will have plenty of opportunities to refill them during the day.

***Although you may have listed food allergies on the medical form, *please confirm with our staff at drop-off on the first day* to ensure we have it in our records.**

WHAT YOU SHOULD PACK FOR THE DAY!

- A large, refillable water bottle with your child's name on it.
- A raincoat every day, as rain can come in fast and unexpectedly frequently.
- hat to help protect against the sun.
- Application of sunscreen or bug repellent **must occur at home**, before class.
 - Our staff members cannot assist with this.
- Students should wear clothes that can get both dirty and wet as we utilize the hose for various barn chores and farm activities
- We recommend your child wear old sneakers, hiking boots, or tall rubber muck boots.
 - Absolutely **no sandals, flip-flops, or Crocs!**
 - Footwear may get wet, muddy, and covered in manure (from entering animal pens).
 - It's recommended that students arrive with a change of shoes and socks.
- Work gloves are often helpful
 - Please label them with the student's name
- These items can be stored in the education barn for the class week, for convenience.

CELL PHONE USE:

We do not permit cell phone use at Barn School. Cell phones should be left at home, but if a student has one with them, they will be stored away during class sessions. If a child needs to contact a parent, they should inform their instructor and a call will be facilitated.
