

No Prep Wixie Ideas

All of these activities are accessible by students through the Wixie app on Classlink.



The new button is found at the top left of the screen. Students select it to start these projects:

- **Graphic Organizer:** Dozens including Circle Map, I see I think I wonder, sequencing, storyboard, comparing organizers, 4 boxes, timeline, etc.
- **Book**: Students complete writing assignments in a book
- Blank Page: Journal responses and exit tickets (use Chromebook camera or webcam)
- Blank Page: Draw/show math problems and record audio or video on how you solved it.
- Blank Page: Record reading a text passage and then illustrate. Repeat over a series of days with the same passage to track fluency.
- Blank Page: Video Response to a prompt or question
- Blank Page: One pagers, "posters"
- Blank Page: Illustrate a cycle
- Blank Page: Record a video to tell, retell, or summarize a story
- Blank Page: Interview someone (Explain a Process)
- Blank Page: Illustrate and describe the setting
- Blank Page: Illustrate and describe the main idea, central message, key idea
- Blank Page: Insert dice or spinner to get data for graphing
- Blank Page: Draw and identify shapes
- Start a Talkie: Exit ticket on what you learned today, or questions you still have about today's lesson



The templates folder is found on the left hand side of the screen. Students navigate to the folder and then select it to find these activities:

- **Comics**: Describe a process or historical event
- Math: Grids, Hundreds Chart, Multiplication Charts, Graphs, Ten Frames
- **General**: Trading Card: Biographies, Vocabulary, Animals, Places
- **Design**: Design a t-shirt for a character
- **General**: Trifold for research projects
- Vocabulary: Word wall, word web, Frayer model
- Video: Debate, Investigative Reports, Movie Premiere, Video Response
