Empathy drives our work in the southern Central Valley, an area now referred to as "a new Appalachia." Through our relationships with people in the valley, we've learned:

- Valley residents face many challenges, including knowing how, where, and when to vote.
- Educating residents about the impact of local races and the power of a single voice is critical for voter engagement.
- Top issues include access to clean drinking water, access to health care, and extreme rates of childhood asthma, valley fever, and cancer.

Numbers favor us.

Joe Biden carried the district in 2020, yet a Republican prevailed by a small margin (3,132 votes) in 2022. It is the most Democratic district in the U.S. being represented by a Republican and we want to turn out as many voters as possible supporting the expertise of our strategically vetted, locally based groups.
