Zeva Ven Drakon, is a young female Twi'lek-Togruta hybrid. The color of her skin is a similar shade to her fathers light orangish, but slightly darker. There are traits from both her Twi'lek mother, and Togruta father. While her gentle round face with a tiny button nose is framed by the two prehensile Lekku extending down just past her collar bone, the bases of which connected with her small horn-like Montrals, while she has a third smaller Lekku that extends from the back of her head, all are the same color as her skin. There are curved fainter like orange markings extend from the tips of her Montrals all the way down to the end of her Lekku. Her tiny ear cones are only slightly hidden.

She has her mother's purple eyes, though they are much brighter and starrier, greatly contrasting with her skin. As does the soft white diamond like shapes on each of her cheeks, and the upside down curved triangle taking up most of her forehead, contrast. The last and most unique marking is also white and in the shape of a crescent moon on its side, which can be seen at the base of her throat.
