

**IMPORTANT** - when planning for and applying to Universities, AISD has implemented its own internal deadlines to ensure students are able to complete their applications prior to exams and holiday breaks. It is **highly suggested** that students adhere to the internal deadlines to ensure teachers, staff, and the counselors have ample time to complete all necessary steps to support students in their applications. Additionally, students should complete applications early to allow time for colleges/universities to contact students regarding errors, or the need for more information.

**Please note that holiday breaks often coincide with university application deadlines, thus, please plan accordingly as the counseling office will be closed on weekends and holidays.**

Submission information for popular applications:

**For UCAS Applications -**

1. **The UCAS Buzzword is AISD2026.** This is how you link your application to me and AISD.
2. **Students must pay and submit their application BEFORE I add in the predicted grades and your recommendation.** This is why it is so important you pay and submit your application early!
3. **Once you pay and submit your application, I will upload your recommendation and your predicted grades, and will submit your application to UCAS.**

**For applications via the Common Application -**

1. **You must add me as your Counselor within each college/university you are applying to**
2. I will go in and complete the school profile, school information, grades and transcripts, etc. and the counselor recommendation
3. **You must add in your teacher(s) information for letters of recommendation**
4. Your teachers will then receive an email with a link - this is how they will complete their recommendations.
5. **You will pay and submit your applications\*\*\***

**\*\*\*DO NOT WAIT to pay and submit your Common Application. Pay and submit your application as soon as you are done. Your teachers and I will complete our sections separately to your application.**

**For University of California Applications -**

I will not upload anticipated grades, transcripts, etc. as the UC system does not require these items as part of the application, and I do not have access to your UC application. You will complete and submit your application on your own.

If you would like for me to look over your application, you must make an appointment with me.

**For other universities/uni systems around the world -**

In most cases I cannot access your application, so if you want help/support, you need to meet with me and I can go over your application.

Note in some cases YOU will have to upload/submit the recommendation letters from your teachers, your transcript, etc. If you need these documents, you can request them from the [Future Planning Webpage](#)/access them in your Unifrog Locker.
